Purpose:

The intern will gain hands on experience working on promotional and marketing materials. The graphic design intern will work with marketing, development and event staff on a variety of projects throughout the semester.

Responsibilities:

The graphic design intern will assist in creating print promotions for RMHC, produce and update website content, and assist with other projects as needed.

Qualifications:

- Familiarity with social media platforms.
- Proficient in Adobe InDesign, Illustrator and Photoshop.
- Attention to detail and accuracy.
- Should have completed two years of undergraduate study.
- Eagerness to learn and serve.

Time Commitment:

- 5-10 Hours weekly (flexible depending on student credit hours desired)
- After initial training period, much of the internship can be completed out of the office.
- Start and End Dates to be determined by RMHC and the student.
