Ronald McDonald House Charities® (RMHC®) of Mid-Missouri is celebrating 40 years of serving families. The Ronald McDonald House is scheduled to open in spring of 2024. The new Ronald McDonald House will ensure there is room for more families and distance to MU Health Care's new Children's Hospital isn't an added burden for families with a child who is sick.

"While our address has changed over the years, the hope, healing and gratitude remain the same."

Other programs operated by Ronald McDonald House Charities (RMHC) of Mid-Missouri include:

- Happy Wheels Hospitality Cart
 - The Happy Wheels Hospitality Cart serves families who wait hours at MU Health Care's Children's Hospital without leaving the waiting room or their child's bedside. The cart offers personal care items, snacks, and fun activities that bring smiles to parents and kids when they need it most.
- Lunch on the House
 - Every Tuesday and Friday, approximately 60 sack lunches are packed and delivered to families with children in the NICU, PICU and Pediatric units at MU Health Care's Women's Hospital and MU Health Care's Children's Hospital. The complimentary lunches provide families a meal right in the hospital, without parents having to leave their child's bedside.
- Ronald McDonald Family Room® program inside MU Health Care's new Children's Hospital (opening in 2024)
 - The Ronald McDonald Family Room will support parents during their child's medical journey —
 whether it's a break from the clinical environment, a restorative nap or feeling a sense of
 normalcy by sitting down with a cup of coffee. The Ronald McDonald Family Room is
 scheduled to open when MU Health Care's Children's Hospital construction is completed in
 2024.
